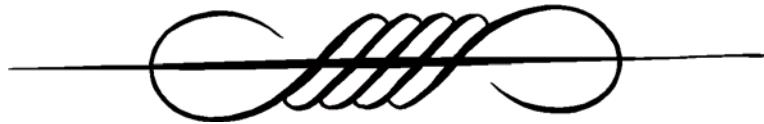


God gives us each a gift of life
