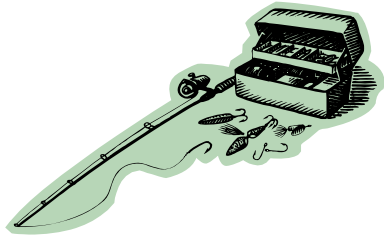


## Afterglow
