



Hilman was born on June 11, 1933, a son of Edwin and Anna (Illehaugen) Ulland in Mayville, ND. He lived with his family in Portland, ND, until his graduation from Portland High School in 1951. He attended Mayville State University and received his teaching degree in 1955. He went to work in Pekin, ND.

In the spring of 1956, Hilman was drafted into the US Army. He proudly served his country, stationed in Germany for two years. He was honorably discharged in 1958. Following his

discharge he returned to Pekin.

In June of 1963, he was united in marriage to Charlene Johnson in Pekin, ND. They lived in Pekin and then moved to McVille, ND, in 1964, where they taught school.
