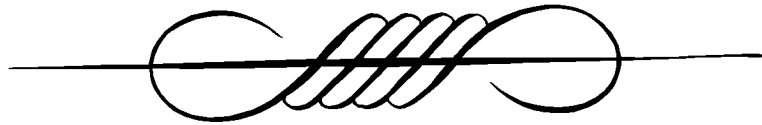
Immediately following the graveside service everyone is invited to join the family for lunch and fellowship in the church fellowship hall.
