for thou art with me;*

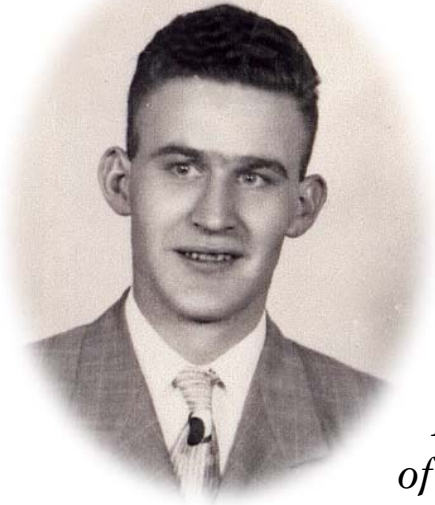
*thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.*
