On March 11, 1966 Larry joined the United States Marine Corps. He served one tour in Vietnam and was awarded the Purple Heart Presidential Unit Citation, National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal and Vietnam Campaign Medal. He was honorably discharged on March 8, 1968. Following his discharge he returned to

He loved his entire family, but had a special place in his heart for his three granddaughters, who called him "Papa." He enjoyed traveling with his wife and many times they traveled to reunions to reunite with his many Vietnam Veteran comrades. Larry was a man with many hats and it wasn't very often he wasn't wearing one. He was a wonderful man that will be deeply missed.
