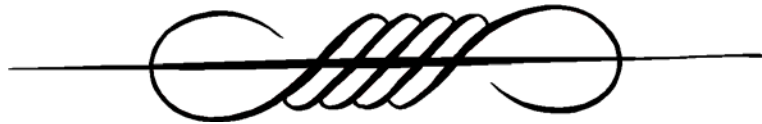
Military Honors by the Army National Guard
