

*He was born on December 31, 1912, in Karlsruhe, ND, the son of John and Elizabeth (Boehm) Bossert. He graduated from Karlsruhe Parochial School in 1928 and Drake High School in 1932. Following his primary education, he attended the University of North Dakota for two years.*

*Nick started farming in 1935, and in 1945, he purchased the Bossert Lumberyard in Karlsruhe and operated it until he retired from farming and the lumber business in 1978.*

*He married Delores Zaback on October 17, 1938, at St. Cecilia's Catholic Church in Velva. Delores died on March 29, 1984, in Minot. Nick moved to Minot in 2000, and lived at Edgewood vista before entering Trinity Homes.*

*Nick's public service included being Mayor of Karlsruhe from 1949 to 1983. He was recognized with the "Certificate of Commendation" for his 34 years of service to the community by Governor George A. Sinner in 1986.*
