

Oscar Beck, 71, Minot, a loving husband, father and grandfather, died Saturday, September 27, 2008 in a Minot nursing home.

Oscar F. Beck was born on June 6, 1937, the son of Herman O. and Hannah K. (Buterbaugh) Beck in Burnside, Pennsylvania. He was raised and educated in the Burnside area, graduating from Burnside High School.

On August 17, 1954, he enlisted into the United States Air Force. He proudly served his country and was stationed in Germany, Turkey, Japan, England, and Grand Forks Air Force Base, ND. He was awarded the Air Force Good Conduct Medal with four Oak Leaf Clusters and the Air Force Longevity Service Award with four Oak Leaf Clusters. He was honorably discharged June 30, 1979, as a Master Sergeant.

Oscar married Sun Cha November 30, 1970, in Grand Forks, ND. Following his discharge from the Air Force, Oscar worked for TCI Cable Company in Minot as an engineer, retiring after 29 years.

Oscar enjoyed collecting stamps, coins, and trains, as well as working with fireworks, computers, and electronics. Oscar especially enjoyed spending time with his family, especially his grandson, Eli.
