The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want.

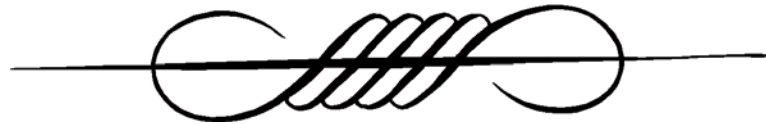
*He maketh me to lie down in green pastures;
