

## ***Frieda “Fritz” Mildred Boelter***

*Frieda was born on October 7, 1913, on the family homestead near Litchville, ND, the daughter of Norwegian immigrants, John and Mette (Trangsather) Paulson. She was reared and educated in the Litchville area and worked on the farm. She married Leo Sand in Valley City, ND on June 2, 1935. He died as results of an accident on September 25, 1938.*

*On November 5, 1940, she married Lawrence Boelter in the Griswold Church in Litchville. They lived in Litchville until moving to Grand Forks where he was manager for the Farmers Union Oil and she was the bookkeeper. They later moved to Glen Ullin, North Dakota where they held the same positions. After a time there, they moved to McVile, ND, where they were partners in the McVile State Bank. Lawrence died in November of 1968. After his death she moved to California for a short time before moving to Minot where she worked for Morelli's Distributing as a bookkeeper. Over the years, she assisted in her family's businesses well into her 90's.*

*Fritz was a member of First Lutheran Church, Minot. She worked in the First Lutheran Fair booth and helped cook rømmegrøt for the First Lutheran Booth at Norsk Høstfest. Fritz put her family first and was a great example to them of her work ethic. She loved music and played the organ and piano.*
