

Hannah Amelia Sevig was born May 25, 1913, a daughter of Peder and Anna (Halvorson) Sevig in rural Palermo, ND. She attended Clearwater Township School. As the oldest daughter of seven children her primary task was to help both inside and outside on the family farm.

Hannah was employed many years as a baker at Piggly Wiggly Store in Minot followed by a number of years in the housekeeping department at Trinity Hospital. For many years her chief love was cooking at the Metigoshe Bible Camp.
